## **BASIC SCIENCE RESEARCH – MEDICAL SCHOOL**

Was involved with a project demonstrating histologic evidence of selective destruction of vestibular hair cells in a frog model with endolymphatic hydrops (produced by surgically occluding the endolymphatic duct) from aminoglycosides delivered through a surgically placed catheter in the vestibule to investigate the effects of intratympanic perfusion of aminoglycosides in patients with Meniere’s disease, 1991-1992.
